About 17% of the over 3,500 homeless Guests we serve each year have mental and/or physical disabilities.



The homeless Guests served through the Angels program have benefit of our Core Services:

- Meals at the Crossroads Kitchen
- Assistance securing their legal identification from anywhere in the United States
- A mailing address to ensure they receive their food stamps, employment and healthcare communications, as well as letters from family and friends
- Placement into detox/addiction treatment if needed
- For those without insurance, free healthcare through our partnership with St. Joseph's Mercy Care

During the past year the Angels program:

- Provided extended Case Management for 135 Guests with an Individual Service Plan (ISP)
- Placed 14 Guests into safe, secure housing
- Helped 44 Guests initial applications for Social Security disability income — for a total of \$99,518 in back pay secured
- Pro-bono legal services saves Guest a total of \$15,086
