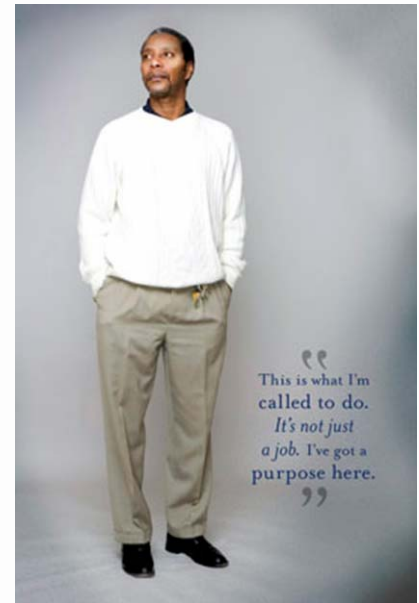


## Our Mission

Empowering people who are homeless to move to economic and personal self sufficiency

### Dominic Heard is the Director of our Renewal Project.

The Renewal Project is a 90-day stabilization program made available to nearly 3,400 homeless Guests each year — *43.5% of which are homeless women and children.*



The Renewal Project offers our homeless Guests a bridge — *a turning point* — to a more hopeful future ...sparked by the accountability and responsibility we require of our Guests.

Case management and Core Services provided over the last year for nearly 3,400 homeless Guests include:

- A hot, daily meal is served in the Crossroads Kitchen
- The mail room — run entirely by dedicated volunteers — provide our homeless Guests with a mailing address so they can receive Social Security benefits, food stamps, employment and healthcare communications, as well as letters from family and friends
- Secured 1,426 birth certificates and 1,515 Georgia ID cards — essential for securing housing, employment and prescription medication
- 307 Guests placed into detox/addiction treatment
- Provided 4,068 MARTA passes
- For those without insurance, free healthcare through our partnership with St. Joseph's Mercy Care
