Many of Crossroads' homeless Guests have substance abuse and mental health challenges. Some have outstanding warrants for long-ago petty offenses that weren't resolved, which block their ability to move forward. When Crossroads' Guests need my legal assistance -- I'm happy to be of help.

Recently a Guest was put in jail and lost their beloved pets. To help ease their mind and heart -- I was able to help determine the pets were placed into loving homes."
