After two years living on the streets — now that Sharon is in her quiet, safe, affordable apartment ...she's starting to dream about her future.

Sharon will tell you that — because of her pride — for years she slept on the street, on porches or in the woods rather than ask for help.

When she got really weary and worn down she turned to Crossroads for help *“Crossroads helped me with everything I have now. I’ve been off of drugs two years now and I’m very proud of myself. You’ve got to be willing to help yourself — and know help is out there, but you have to ask.”*

Today Sharon is working nearly 40 hours a week — and dreaming about her future: going back to school to become an LPN, having a house and a car, and maybe getting married and having kids.
